What we will learn....

Learning Intention: Reading responses are as important as reading. They help us to understand what we have been reading

Success Criteria: I will complete a reading response about my reading

Why do a reading response?

- Responding to a novel is as important as reading the novel.
- When readers express their personal responses to literature freely, they demonstrate their growth as literate learners.
- By responding in a format that suits your learning style, you can reflect on the whole experience of reading the novel and you can expand or modify your understanding

So many responses...

There are lots of different responses you could do, over this week we are going to try out some different responses.

You should be doing a response to your reading at least 3 times a week. This week you will do a different one everyday.

Book Review (continued)

A book review is designed to inform people about a certain book, to encourage them to read it, or discourage them to read it.

It contains facts about the book, but can also include personal opinions.

Often you do this sort of response after you complete a book.

Time to practice

You are going to practice doing a book review.

But first you must do your independent reading for 20 mins and track it.

You can choose to do your book review on the book you are currently reading or a book you have previously read and finished. You could even do a picture story book.

You can print out a copy of the book review sheet if you want or you can just use the headings a guide to complete the book review.
