# Why do a reading response?

- Responding to a novel is as important as reading the novel.
- When readers express their personal responses to literature freely, they demonstrate their growth as literate learners.
- By responding in a format that suits your learning style, you can reflect on the whole experience of reading the novel and you can expand or modify your understanding

## So many responses...

There are lots of different responses you could do, over this week we are going to try out some different responses.

You should be doing a response to your reading at least 3 times a week. This week you will do a different one everyday.

# 3-2-1

Today we are going to look at the 3-2-1

Book Title:	Date:
Minutes Read:	Pages Read
<b>3</b>	things that happened today
<b>2</b>	words or phrases you found interesting
<b>1</b>	thing you're wondering about



## 3-2-1 continued

You need to write...

3 things that happened in the text you read

2 words or phrases you found interesting

1 thing you are wondering about

You need to include the title and subtitles (use the image on the previous slide to help you) and the date.
