

Uniform Policy

RATIONALE

A uniform dress code reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Issues of equality, health and safety, and expense are also factors that contribute to the establishment of the Dress Code.

GUIDELINES

To promote equality amongst all students.

To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.

To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.

To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community.

IMPLEMENTATION

After consultation, the School Council has developed a Dress Code that provides choice for the students, allows for students to safely engage in the many varied school activities, and caters for the financial constraints of families.

The Dress Code applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.

Summer and winter uniforms, as well as a sports uniform will be prescribed, and are required to be worn.

Acceptable jewellery includes stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears and watches. Cosmetics may not be worn at school.

Headgear for religious or cultural reasons is acceptable along with hats consistent with our Sun Protection policy. Sun protection hats should be worn outside in term 1 and term 4.

A "swap shop" will operate a "buy back" scheme for good quality second hand uniforms.

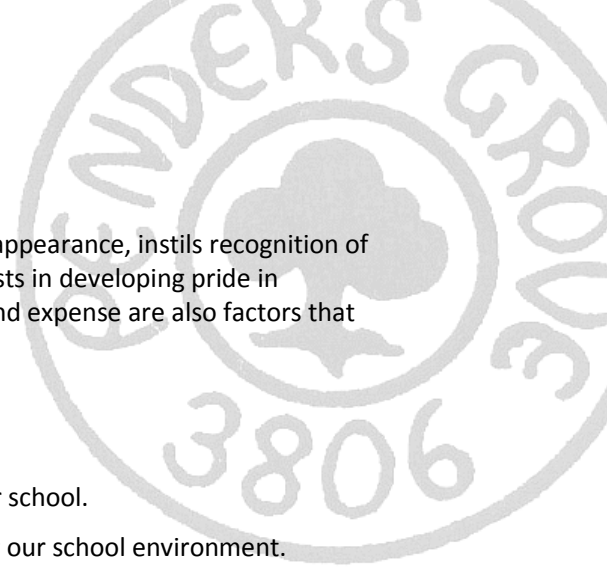
The student Dress Code, including details of uniform items and places of purchase, will be published in the newsletter at the start of each year.

Prescribed Uniform

The compulsory school uniform colours are junior navy and yellow

SUMMER UNIFORM

- Blue and white check dress
- Junior navy shorts
- Yellow T-shirt/ polo shirt
- Navy Skorts

WINTER UNIFORM

- Junior navy windcheater
- Junior navy bomber jacket with yellow stripes
- Yellow polo shirt
- Junior navy tracksuit pants/cargo pants/yoga pants
- Junior navy tunics

SPORTS UNIFORM

- Junior navy shorts
- Yellow sports top with navy trim

HATS MUST BE WORN OUTSIDE IN TERMS 1 AND 4

- Broadbrim
- Legionnaires
- Slouch

IRON-ON LOGOS ARE AVAILABLE FOR T-SHIRTS

T-shirts and windcheaters should show the school logo or be plain yellow for the T shirt or plain navy for the windcheater

*School pants must not have logos, brand names or markings.
