Olive and Aiden represented Penders Grove PS at division cross country event on 5th June 2025. It was a glorious winter day in Melbourne and they did their very best over a 3km course at Bundoora Park. The top 10 runners for each age group move through to the next round (regionals). Olive finished 16th and had a terrific run. Aiden finished 5th in a time of 11 min 20sec and will move through to regionals which will be on 18th June 2025. Congratulations to both Olive and Aiden for their efforts!

In case you missed it last week – in the last two weeks of this term we will be trialling a slightly different structure to our day (see last week's newsletter for details). Breakfast Club will be starting at PGPS! Why have a breakfast club?

The School Breakfast Clubs program is a partnership between the Victorian Government and Foodbank Victoria to address the rates of hunger and disadvantage in the classroom. There are significant consequences of not eating a healthy breakfast that impact negatively on a child's learning and overall wellbeing. Teachers report that students can lose more than two hours of learning time each day when they arrive at school hungry.

Tessa is going to co-ordinate the program but is hoping to have some help from our wonderful community. If you would be interested in potentially helping Tessa (this could be in an admin way, preparing food etc, every bit helps) please come to an informal meeting to get things started.
