
A reminder today about arrival time in the mornings before school as we have noticed a few students arriving at school really early when there is no one in the school yard. Please note that our staff are not on yard duty until 8.45am so if you need to arrive at school prior to this please make use of the Before School care program that is available from 7.00am. We do appreciate that some students are choosing their time to leave home to walk or ride a bike but it would be helpful if parents and carers could follow up with students about how long the trip takes and the best time to leave home. On days when our breakfast club is running students participating in this may be in the LN building eating during this time (8.30-8.45) but teacher supervision in the yard does not begin until 8.45am.

We are currently working on our organisation of the class structure for 2026 at Pender's. If you currently have children in Years F-5 and are planning on leaving the school at the end of the year could you please let us know at the office so that we can include this in our planning. Likewise if you have any friends or family that are still to confirm an enrolment for next year could you encourage them to do this as soon as possible especially if they live outside our enrolment zone. Our Foundation Transition has now started and we want these new students to be able to attend as many sessions as possible.

Thanks to everyone for doing such a great job for the last two weeks wearing their broad brimmed school hat as it is required by our Sunsmart policy in Term 1 and 4. A reminder that we have hats available for purchase in the office if you need one or a spare. As mentioned last week - we do have lots of shade outside for when students do not have their hat at school but a hat is needed for times when we can't avoid being out in the sun.

Lastly today a note for parents that drop off and pick up their children by car to please be mindful of our neighbours as they need to be able to access their driveways and properties during these times also. We know that parking can be difficult but please make sure that you are not blocking driveways, private parking areas or the road when you are dropping off and picking up.
